New loans

After a forced break due to corona, our team started again in July with a selection of women for new loans. The first groups were trained in August and started their loan. Our team was enthusiastic about these highly motivated ladies! For some, the business has suffered greatly from corona. Customers stayed away and so did the income. Second loan for 16 women

Not only training courses have kick started for new groups. We also retrained 16 women as they qualify for a second loan. They have successfully repaid their first loan and also have a clear business plan, their accounting in order and the option to invest themselves. One of these women is Janeth Urio. New: Health insurance

If you had to choose between buying medicine or doing your weekly loan repayment, what would you choose? That choice was made quickly. Also for our ladies. That is why we now mediate in taking out health insurance for all the women we help. For approximately \in 15 it is possible to take out insurance for the whole family. To meet this premium, everyone now receives half as a gift at the start of their loan. If the loan is fully repaid after six months, the remainder of the premium will also be given as a gift. This initiative has been received with great enthusiasm!



Internal Team Training

In August it was our team's turn. Together with Mathew and Irene from the back office, they received three days of training on microcredit. All the options and pitfalls when providing a loan were discussed and the best way to administer the loans. The team can look back on three educational days.
