This year is almost over. It was an intensive year for Pamoja Nguvu, with many new activities. Our team took the training in which they learned to set up a better financial system and improve their reporting. This also led, to their great satisfaction, to more cooperation between the three ladies.

It was a tough year for the women from the project who have a small agricultural business. Climate change is clearly having an effect in Tanzania: After a very dry 2022, fortunately it started raining in March this year, but it didn't stop. The rainfall was often so heavy that roads to the more distant villages were washed away and the women could not go to the market with their products. The heavy rain in October and November, also more than normal, fell exactly at the time of sowing. The result was that many young seedlings were washed away. Through the training of the agricultural expert, we hope that the women will also learn how they can respond to climate change, for example by growing other crops.

Many women are wise enough to temporarily start another business, such as keeping chickens or a small shop. We cannot do much about nature, but we can guide women who adapt their businesses to the circumstances.

What was also new this year was the training in women's rights, given by a lawyer who specializes in this. Many women do not know that domestic violence is not normal. So it's high time to change this.

Please meet Gladness

Gladness has a drugstore, where she sells cough syrup, for example, but also prescription medicine. Before receiving a loan, Gladness was only able to purchase limited inventory. As a result, she had to regularly go to Arusha city to replenish her supplies, which of course took a lot of time. The loan allows her to purchase a larger stock at once. In addition, she was able to purchase a permit for Mpesa payments (payments by mobile phone). Gladness is very happy with this progress. She is an intelligent woman who spoke to us in English. She knows what she wants and thanks to the loan she can now grow her business. Gladness paid off the loan quickly and she is eligible for a second loan

In January, Matti and Monique will again participate fully in the daily activities of Pamoja Nguvu. A training course for the agricultural expert and the lawyer for women's rights is also planned, very interesting to experience this. Of course, travel and accommodation are entirely at our own expense, made possible by dear friends who offer us a stay at their house in Tanzania.
